



MELANIE FARKAS ANNOUNCES RUN FOR LIBERTY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE

Powell, OHIO (March 29, 2021) -- Melanie Farkas, community leader, announced her candidacy for Liberty Township Trustee today. Farkas said she believes she offers a new and needed perspective to the township.

“My love of this community led me to run in 2019, and that hasn’t waned,” said Farkas. “I’m passionate about bringing people together to improve and grow this community responsibly, and being transparent about the planning and decisions being made.”

Farkas believes decisions that impact the community should be data-driven, transparent and only made after careful planning and consultation with experts.

“I believe no decision for our township should ever be made hastily, like the recent POD18D decision. Large developments especially should only be considered if they have been studied extensively by experts to determine the feasibility, benefits and drawbacks, and done with open communication and public input.”

Farkas is also an advocate for improved collaboration with the city of Powell.

“Our current trustees have admitted to approving zoning measures to lock Powell out from annexing north. This “us versus them” mentality must end. For far too long, our township officials have ignored that we have an incredible partner literally in our backyard. It is time to set the politics aside and put together a real partnership.”

Farkas ran for trustee in 2019 and earned 33% of the vote. She looks forward to meeting more people in the community and hearing their hopes for better growth, collaboration and decision making.

“I met so many incredible people during the campaign and was honored to receive their trust and their vote. I hope that we can continue conversations and have open, honest discussions about this wonderful place we live.”

Farkas has lived in Central Ohio for more than 13 years. She is a marketing manager at a large national law firm, a Girl Scout Leader, a Sunday school teacher and active member at Linworth United Methodist Church. She and her husband, Dan, an instructor at the Ohio State University, have two children and live near Tyler Run Elementary School.
